Rules

1. Exhibitors are limited to residents of Lancaster County and adjoining counties in Pennsylvania.
2. Entries: All entries must be mailed along with entry fee to Chairman by September 13th. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until the capacity of the dairy tent is obtained. (Form on page 13.)
3. Health Requirements: No entries showing clinical evidence of infectious, contagious, or parasitic disease or under quarantine for any disease shall be admitted to the show. All entries must be identified by an official ear tag and be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated March 1 or later. It is recommended that all cattle be immunized against IBR, PI3, and BVD. Rabies vaccination recommended.
4. Care: Bedding will be furnished by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. The feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE fair. The Ephrata Farmers' Day Association will provide a night watchman to stay with the animals.
5. Time: All animals for exhibition must be placed in the tent by 10:00 a.m. Tuesday. The animals must remain on exhibit until 10:00 a.m. Saturday, week of fair.
6. Classes and premiums listed below apply to each of the following breeds and apply to both Open and Junior Shows.
7. An "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form" is required. (found on page 13).

Rules

1. All entries must be mailed to Chairman by September 13th. Entry fees and an "Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship Form (found on page 13) must also accompany entry form.
2. Pygmy goat conformation "breed standard" taken from the National Pygmy Goat Association. 4-H, FFA and open exhibitors from Lancaster County will compete in the same class.
3. All goat show entries must have an official health certificate at time of entry. No animal showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease will be admitted to the show. All pygmy goats must be disbudded or dehorned. Animals must have scrapies tattoo, breed registration tattoo, or identification chip.
4. Drugs administered to goats prior to or during the Fair for the purpose of controlling disposition and showmanship performance is prohibited.
5. Bedding will be provided by the Ephrata Farmers Day Association. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed, water pails and feed dishes and is responsible to care for their own animals during the entire fair. The Ephrata Farmers Day Association will provide a night watchman.
6. Arrival time of goats is Monday, week of fair, from 6:00 to 9:00 P.M. Removal of goats is Friday after 10:00P.M. or before 8:00 A.M. Saturday.
7. No more than 2 animals per class for each exhibitor. The committee reserves the right to limit the number of goats per exhibitor to allow for greater number of exhibitors to participate.
