**Rules**

1. Eligibility: Any boy or girl who is a member of a regular organized 4-H Club or FFA Chapter in Lancaster County is eligible to compete.
2. Entries: All entries must be mailed, along with the entry fee, to the chairman by September 13. A signed Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form must accompany each animal entry. Relationship form and entry form are found on page 13.
3. Time: Hog exhibits may be placed Monday evening from 6:00 to 8:30 p.m.
4. Any exhibitor displaying unsportsmanlike conduct will forfeit prize money and will be banned from showing next year.
5. Showing: All animals will be shown by weight classes designated by the Committee. Classes will be made up by weight from 220 to 280 pounds. Hogs weighing under 220 pounds will not be permitted to show or sell. Each entry must be shown by the owner except when the owner has more than one entry per class.
6. Fitting: All hogs entered in the Showmanship Class must be fitted by the exhibitor.
7. Care: Bedding will be furnished by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. The feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE fair. The Ephrata Farmers' Day Association will provide a night watchman to stay with the animals.
8. Health requirements:
  - A. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1 is required.
  - B. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI. Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival may not enter the fair ground.
  - C. Individual animal ID is required. ID options include a plastic, stamped ear tag or a form of official ID (herd tattoo in combination with an ear notch or a state issued metal ear tag or and ISO compliant radio frequency tag).
9. Sale: All hogs must be sold through the Auction Sale on Thursday at 6:00 p.m. All hogs will be tagged and weighed upon arrival and this weight will serve for both show and sale. Market classes can be barrows and/or gilts.

**Rules:**

1. All entries **must be mailed** to the chairman by September 13 (form on page 13).
2. Limit of 3 goats per exhibitor with no more than 2 animals per class for each exhibitor. No Billy goats.
3. Health requirements:
  - A. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1 is required.
  - B. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI). Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival may not enter the exhibition grounds.
  - C. An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form (found on page 13) must be mailed to the Chairman by September 13 along with entry fees.
4. Sale goat exhibitors will be limited to any 4-H or FFA member residing in the following school districts: Ephrata, Cocalico, Eastern Lancaster County, Conestoga Valley or Warwick. No exhibitor may sell more than 2 goats. The committee reserves the right to limit sale goats to 1 per exhibitor depending on the number of entries. The goat must have been on feed at least 45 days before the Fair's starting date.
5. Non-sale goat exhibitors are limited to Lancaster County 4-H or FFA members.
6. Arrival of goats is Monday, week of fair, from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. Removal time of goats is Friday after 10:00 p.m. or before 8:00 a.m. Saturday. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their pens.
7. Weight classes are to be set by the chairperson. Weight can be 50 pounds to 130 pounds.
8. Drugs administered to livestock prior to or during the Fair for the purpose of controlling disposition or showmanship performance is prohibited.
9. Bedding will be provided by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. The feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE fair. The Ephrata Farmers Day Association will provide a night watchman to stay with the animals.
