Rules

1. Each exhibit must have a theme conveying one central idea based on an approved method or practice relative to Agriculture, Agri-Business or Environmental Preservation. Examples: Soil, Water, Wildlife, Recreation, Forestry, Pollution, Landscaping.
2. Each exhibit shall be no larger than 18" long, 8" deep, 10" high.
3. Displays may be constructed of cardboard or wood using specimens, models, slogans, pictures, sketches, etc.

Basis For Judging

1. Attracts attention and originality 30 points
2. Conveys message 40 points
 - Clear relation of parts to whole
 - Teaches a practical lesson, tells the story well
 - Inspires the observer to action
