Basis For Judging

Canned foods to be judged on quality, general appearance, and container-per label information.

Rules

1. Use standard mason-type, clean, clear quart/pint glass jars for preserving and exhibiting fruits and vegetables.
2. Use two-piece self-sealing lids (flat disc and metal screw band - free of rust) for sealing all jars. Canned fruits should have 1/2 inch headspace and vegetables 1 inch headspace.
3. Screw bands must be removed from jars before exhibiting entries **except juices, pickles, relishes and culinary delights**.
4. **Label each entry** with the following: Name of food, Date Canned, Hot or raw packed, Boiling water or pressure canned, and How long processed.
5. Fair personnel are not responsible for spoilage of any canned goods during exhibition.

Basis For Judging

Spreads to be judged on appearance, flavor, consistency, and neatness or package.

Rules

1. Use standard jelly glass with two piece lid.
2. Jams and jellies must be heat sealed. Do not use paraffin on honey spreads.
3. **Do not remove screw bands.**
4. **Label each entry** with the following information: Name of food, Date processed, How processed, How long processed.
5. Fair personnel are not responsible for spoilage of any processed goods during exhibition.

Suggestions to Exhibitors

1. Fruit butter is fruit which is cooked until soft. The pulp is then run through a sieve, making it quite smooth.
2. Honey spreads are fruit products which use honey in the preparation as a substitution for part of the sugar.
3. Jams are a thick, sweet spread with pieces of crushed or chopped fruit.
4. Preserves are like jams except the pieces of fruit are larger.
5. Jellies are a clear, sweet spread made from fruit juice, pectin and sugar, which holds its shape when unmolded.
6. Marmalades are clear, jellylike preserves made from pulp, juice, and rind of fruits. Ex: Citrus fruits.
