Rules

2. The winner must catch the pig and return it to the starting area. Please **DO NOT THROW** pigs into the pen. Rough handling of the pigs in any way will result in automatic disqualification.
3. No one is allowed to interfere after the pig is caught and is being returned to the starting area by the catcher.
4. If the pig frees itself from the catcher, there will be a re-start of the heat.
5. No metal spikes allowed.
6. Only contestants are allowed in the chase area.
7. A contestant who violates any of the above rules will be disqualified.
8. The Ephrata Farmers' Day Association, the Ephrata Area Young Farmers' Association, and the committee will not be responsible for personal injury or accidents.
9. Elimination winners will receive a gift certificate and a blue ribbon. The champion of each class will receive a trophy.
