Rules

1. All exhibitors must be a member of Lancaster County 4-H Dairy Beef Club or an organized FFA chapter and have an approved project book. All 4-H entries are automatically entered through club sign-up. Each exhibitor may only exhibit one animal at the fair. **Entry form on page 18.** This is not an open class show.
2. All calves must be born between Jan. 1 and Feb. 28 of current year. A form must be signed by the farm where the calf was born validating the birth date. The calf must also be eartagged by Club leader by May 1.
3. No calves showing clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease, including ringworm, warts, lice, or mange will be admitted to the show. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated after July 1 must be presented at time of weigh-in. **Vaccinations against the following diseases: IBR and PI3.**
4. There is a minimum weight requirement. All animals entering the show must weigh at least 550 lbs. at weigh in. Animals weighing less than 550 lbs. will not receive entry into the fair.
5. All calves are to be checked in Monday, week of Fair, from 7:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. All animals entered in this show will be sold. Bedding will be furnished by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. Feed, feed box, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor.
