Rules:

- Eligibility: Sale goat exhibitors will be limited to any FFA or 4-H member who resides in the following school districts: Ephrata, Cocalico, Eastern Lancaster County, Conestoga Valley, and Warwick. Non-sale goat exhibitors are limited to Lancaster County FFA or 4-H members.
- Ownership: The goats must have been on feed at least 45 days before the Fair starting date. ENTRY MUST BE SHOWN BY THE OWNER except when the owner has more than one entry per class.
- 3. Entries are limited to 3 market animals per exhibitor with no more than 2 animals per class. For example, if you enter 2 Market Sale Goats, then you will be permitted to enter 1 Market Non-sale Goat. If you plan to enter 1 Market Sale Goat, then you can enter 2 Market Non-Sale Goats.
- 4. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor at least 45 days before the show. Goats may not have been sold at a previous fair.
- 5. Weight classes will be set by the chairpersons. Weight classes range upwards from 60 pounds.
- 6. Only grooming products that are approved for the use on meat producing animals can be used.
- 7. Health regulations:

00900 Female Herd

- A. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection: All goats must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian issued after May 1.
- B. Identification: All goats must be identified by one of the following: an official USDA scrapie eartag, a USDA-approved scrapie tattoo (in addition to individual ID), a USDA-approved custom scrapie

eartag, and ISO-compliant 15-digit eartag (including RFID), or a breed registration tattoo (if the tattoo is legible and the registration certificate accompanies the animal). The animal ID must be included on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.

- 8. Bedding will be provided by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. Feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that the animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE week of the fair. The Ephrata Farmers Day Association will provide watchmen to stay with the animals overnight.
- 9. Goats may be brought to the fairgrounds on Monday between 6:00 and 8:00 P.M. Goats can be removed on Friday at 10:00 P.M. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their pens. If an exhibitor or representative is not present for cleanup, he/she will forfeit premium money. Exhibitor please check in with the officials in charge of load out to make sure the cleanup is accomplished before you leave.
