Rules

1. Eligibility: Any boy or girl who is a member of a regular organized 4-H Club or FFA Chapter and lives in any of the school districts in Lancaster County is eligible to compete.
2. Entries: All entries must be mailed, along with the entry fee, to the chairman by September 13. **Entry form is found on page 19.**
3. All animals will be shown by weight classes designated by the Committee. Classes will be made up by weight from 220 to 290 pounds. Hogs weighing under 220 pounds will not be permitted to show or sell. Each entry must be shown by the owner except when the owner has more than one entry per class.
4. Time: Hog exhibits may be placed Monday evening from 6:00 to 8:30 p.m.
5. Fitting: All hogs entered in the Showmanship Class must be fitted by the exhibitor.

6. Care: Bedding will be furnished by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. The feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor who must see that animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE fair. The Ephrata Farmers' Day Association will provide a night watchman to stay with the animals.
7. Health requirements:
 - A. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within 14 days of exhibition.
 - B. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI. Animals appearing unhealthy upon arrival may not enter the fair ground.
 - C. Permanent individual animal ID is required by an official 840 series radio frequency identification (RFID) ear tag and this number recorded on the CVI.
8. Sale: All hogs must be sold through the Auction Sale on Thursday at 6:00 p.m. All hogs will be tagged and weighed upon arrival and this weight will serve for both show and sale. Market classes can be barrows and/or gilts.
