## Rules:

- 1. All entries must be mailed to the chairman by September 13.
- 2. Market goats cannot be shown in breeding classes and vice versa
- 3. Entries are limited to 3 market animals per exhibitor with no more than 2 animals per class. For example, if you enter 2 Market Sale Goats, then you will be permitted to enter 1 Market Non-sale Goat. If you plan to enter 1 Market Sale Goat, then you can enter 2 Market Non-Sale Goats.
- 4. Sale goat exhibitors must be a 4-H or FFA member residing in Lancaster County only.
- 5. Non-sale goat exhibitors are limited to Lancaster County 4-H and FFA members only.
- 6. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor at least 45 days before the show.
- 7. Weight classes will be set by the chairpersons. Weights can range from 60 pounds to 110 pounds.
- 8. Only grooming products that are approved for the use on meat producing animals can be used.
- 9. Drugs administered before the show for the purpose of controlling disposition, enhancing animal quality or showmanship performance are prohibited.
- 10. Health regulations:
  - A. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection: All goats must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian issued after May 1.

- B. **Identification:** All goats must be identified by one of the following: an official USDA scrapie eartag, a USDA-approved scrapie tattoo (in addition to individual ID), a USDA-approved custom scrapie eartag, and ISO-compliant 15-digit eartag (including RFID), or a breed registration tattoo (if the tattoo is legible and the registration certificate accompanies the animal). The animal ID must be included on the Certificate of Veterinary Inspection.
- 11. Bedding will be provided by the Ephrata Farmers' Day Association. Feed, feed boxes, and water buckets must be furnished by the exhibitor. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that the animals are fed and cared for during the ENTIRE week of the fair. The Ephrata Farmers Day Association will provide watchmen to stay with the animals overnight.
- 12. Goats may be brought to the fairgrounds on Monday between 6:00 and 8:00 P.M. Goats can be removed on Saturday, 7:00-8:30 A.M. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their pens.
